



Active Warning Light



Step 1

User opens SUBARU Care application and taps on the Notification Center in the tab bar.


The user can see the active warning light notification.

The user can see the details of the warning light and can contact Subaru or Roadside assistance by tapping on the Useful Contacts button.



In the list of services, the user can tap on the Warning Lights to enter the service.




Step 2


